It has two major aims; to help people with eczema identify the very individual factors that trigger flares in their condition, and secondly to aggregate these data from all the participants across the country to see if changes in eczema scores correlate with changes in various geographic or time-series data. It currently needs a more stable web host, ideally a virtual private server running FreeBSD. Could you help with this?
