

Proposal for informing the registrant in respect of data access

Where data about a registration, in excess of that available by inspection of WHOIS and/or PRSS, is passed by Nominet to any third party, then Nominet shall inform the registrant by email (at the registrant's email contact if any) of the identity of the third party and the information passed to that third party.

This shall not apply:-

- (a) where the registrant has not provided an email contact address to Nominet
- (b) where the passing of such information is prohibited by law
- (c) where it has been, prior to the passing of such information, shown by the third party, to Nominet's reasonable satisfaction, there is a very substantial likelihood that the rights of others will be damaged by disclosing the fact that such information has been passed.
