1. Reverse domain name tasting

Nominet should consider whether the Best Practice Terms and Registrar agreement already cover this issue and report back to the PAB.

Nominet should review the statistics of domain names that get dropped and re-registered by the same tag (or connected tag) but to a different registrant for evidence of this behaviour within .uk.
