

My understanding of the Nominet concept is that it is a not-for-profit, non-commercial (and therefore trustworthy) organisation, albeit a monopoly, operating on the behalf of Registrants.

Tag Holders register .uk domain names either for themselves or for Registrants in order to make a profit.

That is what Tag Holders do - make money.

With the considerable turnover, monopoly and reserves that Nominet possesses, it would be naive to think that it's Members would not be interested in acquiring control of Nominet by whatever means available.

I support one-member one-vote in order to prevent the jackals taking larger and larger bites of this golden goose.

I personally cannot see the long-term outcome being favourable for anyone other than the shareholders of the large corporates if the voting system is rigged to help block votes to take Nominet over entirely.
