

Option 3 gets it for us. For sure.

Other gTLD Registry operators could learn a thing or two from Nominet, as could some of the companies offering 3rd-party services. I've gone with OpenSRS for gTLD domains (and others, except UK) after lots of painful experiences elsewhere. NSI/Verisign are the scourge of the Internet, second only to Spam, from what I've been able to tell.

So, the idea that Nominet should be able to deliver services in that arena, compete and offer an alternative to those other companies, seems like an excellent proposition, to be encouraged.

The fact that ENUM is also a factor, would seem an urgent necessity. If Option 3 were not possible, then certainly Option 2 as a last resort so that Nominet can do the ENUM thing. I'd always assumed it to be an inevitable, obvious, natural route, without realising there was a constitutional obstacle!
